Join Murdoch University's Education researcher, Dr. Amanda Woods-McConney in an interactive two-way communication approach to learn about how to support 'your girl' in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics studies.

While female and male students achieve at similar levels in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), their continued participation in university STEM enrolment is not the same. The increasing spotlight on the difficulties faced by women in STEM careers can hinder girls from further studies. However, studying STEM develops critical skills that will be essential for jobs of the future.

By attending this event you'll learn:

- How STEM provides girls with a platform of skills from which they can launch successful careers in research, education, business leadership and entrepreneurship
- How to support your daughter in choosing school and university subjects
- How STEM subjects develop critical skills that will be essential for jobs of the future
